The following questions will be used to compose a biographical sketch, which will be included in the information packet that will be mailed to Randolph EMC's entire membership for the purpose of voting in the cooperative's upcoming Board of Directors election. We recommend that you also submit a professional headshot photograph to accompany your bio.

- 1. Where were you born and raised?
- 2. Briefly describe your education, including high school attended, trade school, community college, college, graduate school, etc.
- 3. Please list any college or professional degrees or special achievements.
- 4. Please list information about your spouse, including where he or she is from and how long you have been married.
- 5. Where are you employed; or if you are retired, where were you employed?
- 6. If you are self-employed, list some information about your business, including what kind of business it is, how long you have been engaged in the business, and whether any of your family members are involved.

- 7. Do you attend church? Do you hold, or have you ever held any positions in the church, such as deacon, treasurer, etc.? Please list the length of time served.
- 8. Do you have any political interests? Have you ever been an elected official? If so, what office did you hold and where was it located?
- 9. Please describe any other involvement with entities in the electric co-op industry, such as NRECA, CFC, etc. Have you held any positions within industry-related organizations?
- 10. What are your other interests (e.g., horses, dogs, cars, other hobbies)?
- 11. Please list any other information you would like included in your biographical sketch.
