KNOW WHAT TO DO

if you're in an auto accident involving powerlines

Do NOT leave the car, and warn others to stay away.



CALL 911 to have the utility notified.



WAIT until a professional has told you it's safe. The ONLY reason to exit the vehicle is if it's ON FIRE.



IF THE CAR IS ON FIRE, jump clear of the vehicle WITH FEET TOGETHER, and WITHOUT TOUCHING THE CAR AND GROUND AT THE SAME TIME.



Continue to HOP AWAY with your FEET TOGETHER as far as you can.
